KEPT WITH THE STUDENT

Keep these for your child to bring on the first day of school. It's always a good idea to write name on personal supplies.

SUPPLIES MAY NEED TO BE REPLACED/REFILLED THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.

- 2 inch **Heavy Duty** binder (zippered is okay)
- 1 - 5 pack Avery/Mead (or comparable brand) heavy duty **tab pocket dividers with pouch** → → →
(1-Language Arts, 1-Science, 1-Social Studies, 1-Math, 1-spares)
- 1 pair of earbuds (to be kept in pencil pouch and carried to classes for computer work)
- pencil pouch
- 1 pack of wide-ruled notebook paper placed into binder (8 total packages needed, see below)
- 1 - 24 ct packs wooden (with personal sharpener) OR mechanical pencils (with extra lead)
- Deodorant (for locker – **no aerosol per code of conduct**)
- Texas Instruments TI-30Xa calculator (average cost \$8.97), (NO Ti-30XIIS, it has different keys)
