

Latest Round of Pandemic EBT (PEBT) Benefits to Start Rolling Out This Week -December 10, 2021

Things you need to know for Shelby County Students-

- To gain P-EBT eligibility, households not on SNAP Benefits must be approved for School Meal Benefits at the schools their children attend.
- Children newly approved for School Meal Benefits before open enrollment ends August 31, 2021 will receive the total standard Summer P-EBT amount that the State proposes to issue (\$375 per child).
- The P-EBT program for school age children is based on the School Meal Benefit Application approval. Children under 6 not in school must be signed up for SNAP Benefits to receive the P-EBT Benefits.
- Families with students who received P-EBT benefits previously for the 2020-21 school year can access the new funds on their existing EBT cards. Those who are new to the National School Lunch Program will receive cards in the mail within 20 days. Recipients should keep their cards in case additional benefits are added in the future.
- If you have misplaced your card from last year please call: 1-800-997-8888
- If you have changed your address you will need to update it at your local school.

- If you did not apply for School Meal Benefits, you may do so to qualify to receive P-EBT benefits.
(You will then need to contact the P-EBT Hotline to verify if they will be able to add you at a later date.)
