**We provide a high quality learning environment for Pre-K students in Shelby County. This includes credentialed Lead and Auxiliary Teachers, clean and safe classrooms, and curriculum that promotes developmental, social, and emotional learning. Pre-registration starts in January and a public random selection drawing for the program is held in March. Each Pre-K elementary school has 18 available slots for students, however all students' names that were pre-registered will be in the drawing. This will enable them to be placed on a waiting list should anyone not wish to participate or drop out.**
