

**Wilsonville Elementary School
School-Parent Compact – 1st Grade
2018-2019 School Year**

Wilsonville Elementary School, the parents of the students participating in activities, services, and programs funded by Title I, Part A of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, and students agree that this compact outlines how the parents, the entire school staff, and the students will share the responsibility for improved student academic achievement and the means by which the school and parents will build and develop a partnership that will help children achieve the State's high standards. This school-parent compact is in effect during school year 2018-2019.

School Responsibilities

Wilsonville Elementary School will:

1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student's academic achievement standards as follows:

- *by providing highly qualified teachers
- *by providing instruction that follows the state course of study
- *by following curriculum pacing guides
- *by offering leveled instruction
- *by providing a safe and caring learning environment

2. Hold parent-teacher and student led conferences (at least twice a year) during which this compact will be discussed as it related to the individual child's achievement. Specifically, those conferences will be held during my daily planning time and before or after school.

3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress. Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows:

- *nine- week report cards
- *weekly progress reports (individual teachers)
- *parent conferences (as needed)

4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:

Staff will be available for parent consultations as needed upon request. Consultations will be held at the school after parents call/ write to schedule an appointment.

5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities, as follows:

Parents are able to volunteer or participate in their child's classroom by contacting the teacher by phone call, email, or letter. Parents are able to observe at any time (with exception of testing times) in the classroom.

6. Ensure there is regular, two-way, meaningful communication between family members and school staff, and, to the extent practicable, in a language that family members can understand.

Parent Responsibilities

We, as parents, will support our children's learning in the following ways:

- Monitoring attendance
- Checking my child's folder on a daily basis
- Signing all test and expressing any concerns on my child's work
- Making sure that homework is completed by my child and turned in on time
- Volunteering in my child's classroom.
- Participating, as appropriate, in decisions relating to my children's education.
- Promoting positive use of my child's extracurricular time.
- Staying informed about my child's education and communicating with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school or the school district either received by my child or by mail and responding, as appropriate.
- Serving, to the extent possible, on policy advisory groups, such as being the Title I, Part A parent representative on the school's School Improvement Team, the title I Policy Advisory Committee, the District wide Policy Advisory Council, the State's Committee of Practitioners, the School Support Team or other school advisory or policy groups.

Student Responsibilities

We, as students, will share the responsibility to improve our academic achievement and achieve the State's high standards. Specifically, we will:

- Do my homework and ask for help when I need to.
- Read at least 15 minutes every day outside of school time.
- Give to my parents or the adult who is responsible for my welfare all notices and information received by me from my school every day.
- Always do my best.
